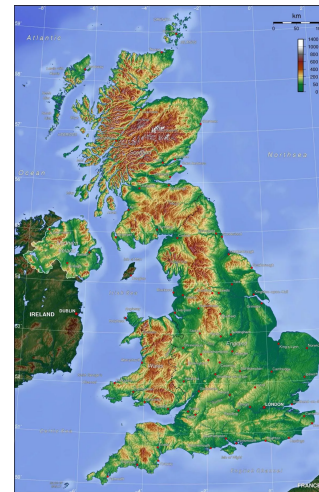

England	southern: mostly flat; 0 - 100m northern: a bit higher; 50m - 300m
Wales	completely high except coastlines; 50m - 500m
Scotland	“highlands” 50m- 1,345m (Mountains); Ben Nevis (1,345m) - highest Mountain of the UK
Northern Ireland	from 0- ca 400m everything flat to middle high
